

## AWARDS

- Ribbon Awards may be given for First, Second or Third place or Honorable Mention to each cultivar in any given section.
- The AIS Silver Medal and Certificate will be given for the most blue ribbons won by any individual in the Horticulture Division.
- The AIS Bronze Medal and Certificate will be given to the person placing second in blue ribbons won in the Horticulture Division.
- The AIS Rosette and Certificate will be given for the Best Specimen in the show.
- The AIS Rosette and Certificate will be given for the Best Seedling of Show. This seedling automatically receives an Exhibition Certificate (EC). Any other seedling receiving five (5) or more votes from accredited AIS judges attending the show will also receive an EC.
- Silver and Bronze medal/certificates and Rosette for Best Specimen of Show, for Division III - Youth will be awarded in the same manner as for the Horticulture Division, providing the section qualifies.
- Under Division IV: Artistic, the AIS Rosette will be given for the Best Design of Show, Best Design of Show - Youth, and Artistic Sweepstakes (Adult and Youth).

At all shows the Queen's Table shall consist of the best blue ribbon specimens from all sections in Division I and the best blue ribbon out of each applicable section, B through Q; DIVISIONS II & III, except P.

Also, Best Club Flower, May early show 'Maui Moonlight' or 'Maui Sunrise', and Late Show 'Red Tessa'.

## SHOW RULES

1. Any iris grower is eligible to exhibit. You need not be a member.
2. The show is being held under the auspices of The American Iris Society. Official rules and regulations of The American Iris Society cannot be violated.
3. The Greater Portland Iris Society and the show location assume no responsibility for any loss or damage to persons or property.
4. Standard award ribbons may be given: Blue, red, white and Pink, with no more than one to each cultivar. This is a cultivar show in which each variety is a separate class.
5. The show committee reserves the right to remove any entry that becomes unsightly.
6. Exhibits must be correctly named by the exhibitor. Unlabeled or mislabeled irises will be disqualified.
7. Entries will be received at the show from 8:00 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. on the show day. Judging at 10:00 a.m.
8. Entries may not be removed prior to close of show except by direction of the Show Chairman.
9. Horticulture and Artistic judging will be done by accredited judges and all rulings by judges will be final.
10. In Divisions I and III, each exhibitor is limited to one entry of any named variety.
11. All entries in Horticultural must be grown and entered in person by the exhibitor.
12. Containers for the Horticultural Division will be supplied by the Greater Portland Iris Society
13. No iris bloom stalks or pollen are to be sold or taken from the premises by anyone unless the exhibitor directs them to be sold or taken.
14. Bulbous iris, collections, English Boxes and Seedlings are not eligible for the Best Specimen of Show award.
15. An AIS Judge may enter for awards but shall not judge sections in which he/she has entries.
16. Sections may be combined for fewer entries, or subdivided for excessive entries, as necessary, at the direction of the Show Chairman.
17. Exhibits in Division IV-Artistic will be judged using the *Scale of Points For All Designs* as outlined in *The Handbook For Flower Shows* of the National Council of State Garden Clubs, Inc.

2. **BREATH OF SPRING** – three flowers
3. **DESERT SONG** – designer’s choice (Early Show use ‘MAUI SUNRISE’, SDB or ‘MAUI MOON LIGHT’, IB)
4. **LETS DO THE TWIST** – show motion
5. **PEACE AND LOVE** -
  - A. All foliage with iris leaves
  - B. Designer’s choice using flowers

- Youth may enter any of the above but must state their age on each entry.
- Iris must dominate over other flowers used in design. *A small card naming the iris variety used in design is encouraged.*
- Entries must be the work of the exhibitor, but not necessarily grown by the exhibitor.
- Backgrounds, accessories and special lighting are permitted. Artificial plant material, living members of the animal kingdom, landscapes and scenes are not permitted.
- If Club Flower ‘*Maui Moonlight*’ or ‘*Maui Sunrise*’, Early Show; and ‘*Red Tessa*’ Late Show, is not available, a similar iris may be substituted, knowing that a design using the Club Flower will receive more recognition.
- Designers must provide own containers. No valuable treasures. Iris may be provided.
- Exhibitor (s) may enter only one entry per class
