Location: Under the tall for trees in Timber Park, Estacada, OR. (30878 NW Evergreen Way, Estacada, OR 97023).

Everyone bring lawn chairs (blanket if you desire to sit on the ground) and Please bring a main dish, vegetable, salad, or desert to share. Also bring your own plates and silverware. Picnic tables are very limited. Bottled water and lemonade will be provided.

I will bring folding tables to display the plants. I'll have introductions coming from Schreiner's Garden, other people have said they have donations but we need more. If you are bringing donated plants, please mark with name, year and have a picture attached.

Payment for purchases can be made by cash, personal check or credit/debit card.

Direction to Timber Park: Hwy I-205 Exit 12B (same exit if you were going to the February luncheon). Follow the signs to Estacada. Distance to Timber Park - 17.3 miles. Estimated travel time - 25/30 minutes.

Head East on OR 212E (becomes OR-224) for 3.2 miles to Rock Creek junctions (stop light) - stay in right lane. Turn right on OR-224E. Travel 1.1 miles to Carver.

At Carver Junction (stop light) take a slight left on OR-224E going to Estacada.

Stay on OR-224E for 12.9 miles to Timber Park exit. Stay in right lane. Watch for large sign "TIMBER PARK".

Turn right off OR-224E onto NW Evergreen Way and another immediate right into the park entrance. (if you miss the entrance and arrive in Estacada proper, you have gone to far.). Park in the first parking area on left side of main road.
